Catherine Matzke Drapela of El Campo died suddenly February 24, 2019 at the age of 89. She was born September 1, 1929 in Crescent to the late Raymond and Linnie Maerz Matzke. Mrs. Drapela was the most amazing woman I've ever known. Every day she tackled a veritable mountain of laundry and cooked enough food to feed a platoon of hungry marines (she was a great cook, too). All the while, she was always smiling and laughing; I never saw her without that beaming smile of hers. She took time every day to interact with each of her kids and any house guest. She and her husband Charlie "Doc" Drapela always had an endless supply of interesting stories to tell.

Mrs. Drapela was already the busiest woman in town when, with the family still growing and her involvement with civic and church activities, she took on the job of County Commissioner after Doc Drapela passed away, and did a great job of that while continuing to fulfill the role of the family matron.

With all that going on in her life, whenever she spotted me at a wedding or funeral dinner she would recognize me even when she hadn't seen me for years (I had moved out of town) and call me over and catch up with up with me about what was going on in my life and her kids' lives -still taking an interest.

In conclusion, I can honestly say I have never known a more amazing human being. I was truly blessed to have known her. Make no mistake, the El Campo community has lost someone very special indeed.
