Leola Mae Ramsey passed away peacefully at her residence in El Campo, Texas on August 18, 2018. She was born on August 9, 1921 in El Campo, Texas to Jesse Lee and Minnie Mae Atkisson Myatt. She had just celebrated her 97th birthday surrounded by family and friends.

“Sis” as she was affectionately known, married Frank L. Ramsey in 1942. After the war, they made their home in El Campo and raised four children; Rebecca, Dick, Anita and Phyllis.

Sis is survived by her children, Rebecca Powers (Jimmy) of Sonora, Richard (Dick) Ramsey (Teresa) of El Campo, Anita Richards of Sugar Land and Phyllis Lawhon (Joe) of Lampasas, 10 grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren, her sisters Rita Radley of El Campo and Pat Elliot of Lake Village, Arkansas and numerous nieces and nephews. A graduate of Texas Christian University, Sis went on to teach for over twenty years until her retirement from El Campo ISD in 1992. She was a tireless advocate for her students and would smile with pride whenever a former student went out of their way to greet her. Sis found a way to support many youth activities even after her children were no longer involved. FHA, 4-H, FFA, Texas High School Rodeo Association and the National College Rodeo Associations were all recipients of her time, talent and treasure throughout the years.

She took great pride in her community as a member of the El Campo Garden Club, First Presbyterian Church Ladies Circle and the El Campo Bridge Club where spending time with her lifelong friends provided immeasurable joy. She loved cooking for her family and

friends. It was a given that when a meal or dessert was needed, Sis was sure to arrive with the perfect dish.

Whether you called her Mother, Sis, Gigi, Mrs. Ramsey – she left her mark on this earth. She found the beauty in all things, especially the bright and colorful – from her favorite color red to all the vibrant colors in the butterflies she loved. Her zest for life was contagious, her energy uncontained. She was above all a loving wife, mother, grandmother and caregiver who instilled her strong family values in her children. Her grandchildren and great-grandchildren were the light of her life and she excelled in her role as their Gigi.
