



A. L. Tarver

January 31, 1923 - May 21, 2014

A.L. Tarver, 91, of El Campo passed from this life May 21, 2014. He was born January 31, 1923 in Cisco, Eastland County, Texas to Nathaniel Jasper Tarver and Abigail Belknap Tarver.

A.L. attended school in Cisco, Texas as a child, and also took a welding course at Cisco Junior College at a later time.

He was a member of CCC Camp in 1939 for 6 months helping build mule trails at the Grand Canyon for fifty cents a week. He then joined the the US Navy in 1940 at a young age, serving 3 years in the South Pacific aboard the USS Kilty, and was honorably discharged in October 1945.

A.L. married Verna Lee Doyle in July 1945, after a 2 week courtship. Settling in Cisco, Texas, they began a family, having 3 daughters while living in the area. In 1952 the family moved to El Campo, Texas, where he began working at Transcontinental Gas Pipeline. During the years in El Campo, they had 2 more daughters and a son, while continuing to work for Transco and raise his family until retiring in 1986. He then began a second career at Walmart in El Campo, assembling merchandise, eventually specializing in bicycle assembly. He retired from Walmart in August 2008.

His marriage to Verna spanned a period of 68 years. Through this union, a legacy of love, family values, and family traditions began a lifelong way of

living for his entire family to carry through the generations. The family enjoyed their summers at Garner State Park for more than 47 years. His last trip to Garner was only 2 weeks before his death, where he attended a Tarver Family Reunion.

He grew up in a time of good work ethics, so passing those values on to children and grandchildren was a must. Besides always keeping a large yard mowed and manicured, he always kept a watch on anyone who parked on his nice green grass. He also grew a very large vegetable garden, not only to feed his family, but also to share with friends and relatives.

He met his cronies for coffee and breakfast for 28 years, 7 days a week.

In his last few months, after the loss of his beloved wife, he enjoyed the companionship of a 15 year old little Chihuahua named Lacey, and spent afternoons sitting outside admiring the eight miniature ponies he raised.

He truly loved his children and grandchildren, and they all loved their "PA-PA".

A.L. was preceded in death by his parents, wife Verna Lee Doyle Tarver on August 20, 2013, daughter Tanya Tarver, and grandsons Jarred Farrar and Vince Schnurpel and 17 sisters and brothers.

He is survived by his daughters Glenda Hemphill and husband Ed of Canyon Lake, Judy Hunter and husband Jimmy of El Campo, Rhonda Farrar and husband Garron of El Campo, Janet Wiggins and husband Craig of Montgomery, and son Randy Tarver and wife Debbie of El Campo.
