



Albina Monica Hermis

November 30, 1912 - August 10, 2017

Albina Hermis, 104 years old, joined the Lord on the 10th of August, 2017, while surrounded by her loved ones. Born in Moravia, (old country) Czechoslovakia, November 30th, 1912, she traveled with family by ship when she was 8 years old. After a 13 day travel, she stepped foot on US soil looking up at the Statue of Liberty, calling her the "Green Lady". Albina's mother, Maria (Kocian) Krpec and other family members joined her father, Michael Krpec, in LaGrange, Texas where the family made a life for themselves. Albina's youth was spent working around the homestead, helping and learning the life of a homemaker.

Albina met her husband early months of 1932. She and Felix Hermis wed eight months into their courtship. They moved from LaGrange and settled in New Taiton, Texas, where life began for them. In between caring for her 6 children, Albina gained US Citizenship in 1945 by having to take a citizenship test, as well as reciting the "America- My Country 'Tis of Thee". Late '70s, Albina and Felix moved to East Bernard, Texas, where she continued to live till 2006, when she moved to Boling, Texas. Up until her mid-90's, Albina was self-sufficient, living on her own. As time progressed, Albina at 101 years old, eventually moved to Avalon Nursing Home in Wharton, Texas, where she continued her life till 104 years old. Albina was loved by many at Avalon. The staff felt that her smile was contagious, as she brought joy to strangers that eventually became new friends.

Albina was a dedicated member of the Catholic faith and a member of the

Incarnate Word. She was known for her many prayers for her family and for her health. Thru the years, Albina was known for her many dozen loaves of bread and kolaches, along with her handstitched blankets and clothing. She was a wife, mother, homemaker, babysitter and caretaker. She has witnessed the life of horse and buggy, all the way to the common day technology of FaceTime.

Preceding Albina in death is her husband, Felix Hermis, her parents, Michael and Maria Krpec, her children- John Michael Hermis, Mary Ann Hermis, Jerome Hermis and Bernadett Vacek-Adamek, along with her son-in-laws Innocence Vacek and Robert Kolacny. Also preceding Albina are her grandchildren Robert Hermis, Wayne Hermis and Harvey Hermis.

Albina is survived by her children, Emilia Kolacny, Frank Hermis and spouse, Mary. Her grandchildren, Rob Kolacny and wife, Stephanie, Kim Parnell and husband, Reagan, Kenneth Kolacny and wife, Lorie, Jessica Vela and husband, Ruben, Joseph Vacek, Sr and wife, Linda, Rebecca Schmidt and husband, Craig, Karen Carter and husband, Edward, Glen Hermis, Jerome Hermis, Jr., Jennifer Medina and husband, Lupe, and Michael Hermis.
