Albina Taylor was born on September 10, 1929 in Hillje to August & Pauline Pauler Popp. She was the oldest of 6 children.

Albina grew up on the farm, helping her parents tend crops & taking care of her siblings. She loved to race her brother with the donkeys plowing the fields.

She married Walter Taylor after dating for 4 years on October 26, 1948. They celebrated 65 years of marriage in 2013. They farmed for 5 years before Walter went into construction. They had 4 children, Doris born in 1950, Paula born in 1954, Randy born in 1959 & Donna born in 1963. The family moved to their current residence at 1525 Sandy Corner Rd, El Campo in 1960.

She loved to tend her yard & garden. She had the original green thumb. She would grow 8-10 rows of strawberries and pick gallons of them. She would harvest and can tomatoes & cucumbers for herself and all of her children. It was not uncommon for her to can 250 quarts of pickles and about 200 pints of tomato juice, catsup & picante every year. Her pickles are famous throughout all the family & friends.

Albina poured her heart & soul into raising her family. She loved to spend time with them & valued each gathering. She prayed and worried over the safety & health of each child, grandchild, great grandchild and great great grandchild. Family was everything to her and she took great pride introducing each family

member to whomever she ran into. Even on her last hospital stay she would proudly announce that she had 58 wonderful family members.

She loved greatly and was greatly loved. She was the rock and foundation of her family. She will be deeply missed.
