Alphonse John "A.J." Fucik of El Campo died October 5, 2018 at the age of 78. He was born July 10, 1940 in El Campo to the late George Frank and Sophie Naiser Fucik, Sr. He was a retired longtime commercial bee keeper and had served as President of the Texas Bee Keepers Association. He was an avid hunter and fisherman.
