Amber Jo Koehn was born to Dwight and Tamara (Seaman) Koehn on October 24, 1984 in Vicksburg, Mississippi, and passed away on February 18, 2021 in Manvel, Texas at the age of 36 years. The family moved from Louisiana to Texas in 1988 and she attended El Campo Mennonite School in her elementary years. At the age of 15 she was baptized into the Church of God in Christ, Mennonite in El Campo, Texas by Minister Norman Koehn. After completing grade school, she obtained her GED and worked on her dad's construction crew, skillfully operating heavy earth moving equipment before continuing her education to become a licensed massage therapist and later a physical therapist assistant.
