Annie L. Jurasek Dolezal , 92, of Palacios, passed away on March 3, 2020. She was born on April 12, 1927 in the Gobbler's Creek area of Wharton County near El Campo to the late Charles and Albina Fiala Jurasek. She attended schools in the Carancahua, Midfield, and Palacios areas. She married Victor Dolezal on June 25, 1946 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Blessing. To this union were born 2 children: Helen and Billy. During their married life, they lived in the Palacios area.

Annie was a former Pro Shop Manager of the Palacios Gulf Course for 5 years. She retired from the Palacios Independent School District in 1998 after 24 years of service.
