Bill Biggerstaff of Pierce passed away May 9, 2025 at the age of 92. He was born May 6, 1933 in Mt. Vernon, Texas to Steve and Winnie Vick Biggerstaff. He came to Pierce in 1951 where he was a lifelong cattle man on the Pierce Ranch Cattle Dept. He married his beloved wife, Foy Jean Tinsley Biggerstaff in 1952. He was a member of First Methodist Church.

He was active in all things that involved quarter horses and supporter of all youth rodeo activities. He was a founding member of the Wharton County Quarter Horse Breeders Assoc., founding member of the Wharton County Sherriff's Posse, served on the board of the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo Quarter Horse Division, member of Rockin W Youth Rodeo Assoc. and Matagorda County Youth Rodeo, Pierce 4-H Club leader, and was a pickup man for many rodeos. In 1986 was recognized as the Wharton County 100 Club Citizen of the Year.

He is survived by his wife Foy Jean Biggerstaff of Pierce; son Mark Biggerstaff of Pierce; daughter in law Jo Etta Biggerstaff of El Campo; sister Suzette Cooper of Talco, TX; and grandson Blake Biggerstaff of El Campo. He was preceded in death by his parents, son Billy Jack Biggerstaff and infant son Michael.
