Calvin Ray Brock, 79, of El Campo, Texas, passed away peacefully on February 11, 2026, surrounded by those who loved him dearly.

Calvin was born on November 28, 1946, in Fargo, North Dakota. He lived a life marked by humor and deep love for his family. He was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather, as well as a loyal friend others could always count on.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 57 years, Beverly Sue Kelley; his children, Kelley Rae Brock and her wife, Sherri Shreiber; Robert William Brock and his wife, Sandra Osgood; and Andrew Michael Brock and his wife, Tabetha Rachal.
