Carl Henry Priesmeyer was born on January 7, 1934 in El Campo to the late Henry and Adela Lutringer Priesmeyer. Carl went home to be with the Lord on June 21, 2017 surrounded by his loving family. He lived in El Campo all his life and was a graduate of Crescent High School. He married Dolores Hubenak on November 21, 1955. In 1957, he joined the Army Reserves and served for 5 years.

Carl was a man of many gifts and talents. His jobs included fertilizer manager of Rice Farmers Co-op, maintenance supervisor for Louise ISD, and his last career as a parts delivery man for Superior Motor Parts brought him much joy as it included numerous coffee breaks with the mechanics.

Carl was a lifelong Catholic and an active member of St. Philip Catholic Church. He was a member of the Usher Club and an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist for several years. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council 2490. He was also very dedicated to the Boy Scouts of America for many years as he guided his sons along the path to Eagle Scout. He was a Cub Scout Master and BSA Scout Master and was a member of the Order of the Arrow. He was awarded the St. George Award and the Bronze Pelican Award in recognition of his spiritual development of Catholic youth in scouting. He worked with the Cub Scout and Boy Scout Retreats for several years.

One of the loves of Carl's early life was going to his family farm every Sunday where he taught his children the meaning of hard work by making them pull cotton, potatoes and corn as well as many other farming adventures. He had
