Carolyn Martha Kulcak Foegelle, 83, was called to Heaven on Saturday, February 7, 2026. She was born on July 1, 1942 in El Campo, Texas to Charlie and Martha Kulcak. She was undergoing treatment at St. Luke's Hospital in Sugarland when she passed.

She attended St. Philip Catholic school and was a graduate of El Campo High School, class of 1960. She attended Red Bluff Beauty College in Pasadena, Tx for one year.

Carolyn worked for Wharton County Junior College for 22 years where she was the secretary for the Maintenance Department for the college.
