returned to El Campo, where Catherine was a member of the Women's Club, Community Bible Study, and TOPS. Even in her later years, you could see her in the mornings at 6:00 a.m. waiting for the aquatic center to open for her aerobics class.

The family business, Lundy Vacuum Service, was influential to their lives for 50 years. They also loved their beautiful pecan orchards at their River Bend Ranch which provided pecans to south Texas for many years.

Catherine's life was very rich in the memories of many other organizations in which she gave her time and resources. Catherine was well known for her kindness, grace, uncompromising moral values and compassion. She was selfless in always helping others, while taking no credit for herself, but instead for the glory of God. Catherine was a good friend to so many and treasured by all she touched.
