



## Cay Krueger Scheumack

August 24, 1951 - September 29, 2025

Cay Krueger Scheumack, 74, of El Campo, passed away peacefully on September 29, 2025 after a battle with bladder cancer.

Cay was born on August 24, 1951 to Evelyn and Culp Krueger. She was raised in El Campo, and lived a vibrant life in Wyoming, El Campo, and Rockport, Texas. Cay graduated high school a year early and left Texas to attend the University of Wyoming. In 1983, Cay married C. Cay was an integral part in managing the family businesses including the construction and renovation of beautiful homes in the Rockport area.
