Charles E. Osina, Jr. of El Campo died February 3, 2013 at the age of 95. He was born on August 1, 1917 in Holman, Texas to the late Charles E. Sr. and Cecilia Knebel Osina. He was a pole setter for Wharton County Electric Co-Op, retiring in 1983.
