



Dennis D. Egmon

December 6, 1942 - July 31, 2024

Dennis D. Egmon, 81, of El Campo, Texas, passed away at his home on July 31, 2024, after a valiant fight with mesothelioma. He was born on December 6, 1942, in East St. Louis, Illinois, to the late William Egmon and Wilma Egmon Johnson.

He graduated from Brazosport High School, attended Wharton County Junior College, and earned his bachelor's degree from Sam Houston State Teachers College. He later obtained his master's degree in Education Administration and Supervision and his Superintendent's certification from The University of Houston. He met his wife, Altje, at WCJC, and they married on May 30, 1964. They spent most of their marriage residing in El Campo, Texas, where they raised their four children.

Dennis had a varied career including work as a millwright, an engineer at General Electric, and an entrepreneur owning a local restaurant. But his most rewarding role was as an educator. Throughout his twenty-plus year career in education, he served as a teacher, coach, and Director of Career and Technology Education.

He is survived by his wife of 60 years, Altje Manske Egmon; daughters Beth Egmon of Sugar Land, Cheryl Egmon of El Campo, and Laura Egmon (Landon Schwausch) of Pflugerville; son Wade Egmon (Cristina) of

Friendswood; grandchildren Caleb, Hallie, and Owen Egmon; sister Judy Northrup of Lake Jackson; brother Sean Egmon (Lisa) of Milan, Michigan; and numerous nieces and nephews. Dennis was preceded in death by his parents.

A memorial service to celebrate the life of Dennis will be held at 2:00 pm at Christ Lutheran Church, 1401 Ave I, El Campo, Texas, on Sunday, August 4, 2024, with Pastor Wayne Clement officiating.

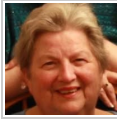
