Donald M. Majure went home to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on January 30, 2018. He was born in Syracuse, New York, on June 21, 1940.

Don grew up in Peoria, Illinois, and was a graduate of Southern Illinois University, where he received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Chemistry. He worked as a chemist for many years. Don and his family moved to El Campo and purchased the Western Auto in 1974, where they had many successful years operating the business. Don, however, was not sure what he wanted to do when he grew up, until he drove tractor-trailer trucks. He logged more than one million miles on the road, and he loved every minute of it, listening to the Bible on CD. Don and his wife Doris attended church at Rescue Church in Wharton, Texas, where he served as an elder. Don especially loved watching young Christians grow into the people that God had destined them to be. He was a mentor to many young Christians in the church, and his legacy will live on in their lives.

He is preceded in death by his parents, William and Jean Majure. He is survived by his wife of 56 years Doris Majure of El Campo; his siblings, Lynne Majure of Denver, Colorado; Susan and Ed Sager of Alberta, Canada; Jack and Lynn Majure of N. 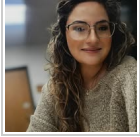

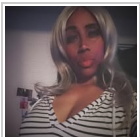
