Doris Joann (Christiansen) Haddock was born January 7, 1919 in Danevang, Texas to Elizabeth D. Hansen and Mortorse "Martin" S. Christiansen. She went to be with her Heavenly Father May 7, 2012. Doris was 93 years of age, and the oldest of four children.

Doris married Rev. Arthur F. "Art" Haddock, January 17, 1939, and lived in El Campo, Texas. They had two children, Thomas "Tom" M. Haddock, and Nancy J. Haddock Meissner.

Doris was a member of St. Paul United Methodist Church (former EUB), joining in 1942. She was Past Matron of The Order of the Eastern Star, and a member since 1945. She moved to Jacksonville, Texas in 1993, where she attended St. John's United Methodist Church. In 2009, she moved to Georgetown, Texas where she resided with her daughter and son-in-law.

Doris was preceded in death by her parents, her husband of 50 years, Rev. Art Haddock, her son Major Tom M. Haddock, USMC (Ret), brother Vernon "Sonny" Christiansen, sister Elsie Lee "Tootie" Dippel, and brother Martin Julian "Julio" Christiansen.
