



Doris Marie Otradovsky

November 1, 1931 - January 28, 2017

Doris Marie Rod Otradovsky, 85, of El Campo, passed away January 28, 2017. She was the first of four sisters born in the Blue Creek area on November 1, 1931 to the late Louis and Mary Baklik Rod. Doris graduated from Crescent High School and married Rudolph Henry Otradovsky on June 26, 1950. For a short period of time after their marriage they lived in Bonus, TX, then moved to Wharton. They made their permanent home in the country called Friendly Corner, six miles from El Campo. Doris lived a simple life. She enjoyed getting together with her sisters and canning an assortment of vegetables during the summer at their mother's home. Doris was a stay at home mom who raised five children. She loved to cook, bake and sew clothes for her children.

She is survived by her daughters, Barbara Novak and husband Bennie of El Campo, Debbie Fitzgerald and husband Alan of Lane City, Kathleen Helfer and husband Weldon of El Campo, Suzanne Brown of El Campo; son, Alfred Otradovsky and wife Rae of El Campo; 13 grandchildren; 14 great-grandchildren and sisters, Jocelyn Rod Smith of El Campo, Isabel Rod Voldan of Wharton and Jeanette Rod Labay of Ganado.

Doris was preceded in death by her parents; her husband and infant son, David Otradovsky.
