Dorothy Anderlohr passed peacefully into the arms of her Savior on June 2, 2019 at the age of 91 in El Campo, Texas. She was born on February 4, 1928 in Houston, Texas and married William J. "Andy" Anderlohr on April 20, 1943 in Corpus Christi, Texas.

Dorothy worked for the Corpus Christi Caller in the late 1960's to early 1970's as a proofreader. Her job was to read each article written and correct any spelling or grammatical errors before they were published. You might say she was one of the first spellcheckers before computers arrived on the scene to do the job.

As a result she became her husband's, children's and grandchildren's personal English teacher. Andy, her husband, would often speak improper English just to rile her into a frenzy. She would then launch into a long drawn out session chastising us to all speak PROPER English. She would tell us, "You will never gain respect or get a good job if you cannot speak well."

Dorothy loved Texas and was a huge Texas history buff. Because she loved reading, she read every book in the Texana section of the public library.
