Earlene Henrietta Krause Glaze, 102, of Bedias passed away on October 16th, 2024. She was born January 27, 1922 in Crescent to Joe Krause and Annie Treybig Krause.

She lived in El Campo her entire life until 2013 and then moved with her family to the Huntsville area. While clerking at Sam Bishkin Department Store in 1946, Earlene Krause was chosen Miss El Campo and represented her hometown at the Bathing Beauty Revue held in Sequin at the Fourth of July Celebration. She was a homemaker until the death of her husband, Babe, in 1970. At that time, she took on the role of farmer/rancher managing the farm and caring for her cattle. She could be seen feeding 50 lb bags of salt and meal on the coldest of days and shooting over the top of the geese with a "243 rifle" because they were eating her cattle's rye grass. She loved taking care of her yard and won Yard of the Month. She was a perfectionist and took great pride baking her kolaches and buttermilk pound cakes. She always cared for others and helped on the bereavement committee at Trinity Lutheran and Christ Lutheran Churches. While in Huntsville, she became a member of the Red Hat Society enjoying luncheons and activities. She was also a member of The Order of the Eastern Star for 50 years.

Earlene is survived by her daughters Linda Glaze of Huntsville, Rhonda and husband Red Edmonds of Bedias. Two Grandsons Clay Fancher and wife

Shana of Marble Falls, Justin Edmonds and fiancé Shayna of Bedias, and Granddaughter Stacy Fancher of Valley Mills. Great-grandchildren Shaelyn Fancher of Valley Mills, Oaklynne Rho Edmonds, Rylee Parker and Aarian Parker of Bedias. Great-great grandson Daniel Shalom of Valley Mills.

She was preceded in death by her parents, sister Trula Marek and husband C.E. "Babe" Glaze.
