June 5, 1932 - December 12, 2025

Elray Matzke of McKinney, formerly of El Campo, died December 12, 2025 at the age of 93. He was born in El Campo June 5, 1932 to Walter W. and Antonia Hermann Matzke. He married Colleen Melburn Matzke, M.D. on December 27, 1968.

Elray was one of the first Ricebirds and under his leadership, the team went to many Championship games. He was awarded a full football scholarship to the University of Houston, and then played for the Ft. Hood Tankers during his military service. He was appointed President of the University of Houston Letterman.

He farmed the Matzke family land for many years. His greatest loves were his wife Colleen, who commuted from her work at Texas Medical Center to help him at the farm, and fishing. The couple fished together and they won many fishing tournaments. He was a great cook taking many classes under Jacques Pepin and Mary Nell Reck. Elray also enjoyed traveling, skiing, and dancing. Elray is survived by his wife of 56 years, Colleen Matzke, M.D. He was preceded in death by his parents, brother Walter Matzke, and grandparents Herman and Sophie Embrock Matzke, who had 12 children in El Campo, including Eugene Matzke who was an Air Force Pilot who died on Christmas Eve during WW II.

Visitation will begin 1:00 pm Thursday, December 18, 2025, at St. Philip Catholic Church with a parish rosary being recited at 1:30 pm. The funeral Mass will begin at 2:00 pm in the church with Rev. Dalton Ervin officiating.

Entombment will follow at Holy Cross Memorial Park with Military Honors under the auspices of American Legion Post 251.

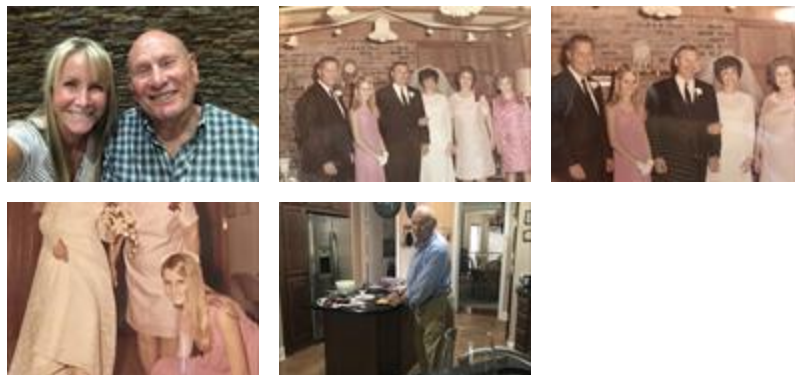
