Frank Anthony Popp Jr., 78 of Garwood, passed away on October 2, 2012. He was born on October 9, 1933 in Garwood, Texas to the late Frank A. and Anne Heine Popp. Frank loved deer hunting, playing dominos and was known for his homemade mustang grape wine.
