December 24, 1939 - October 24, 2023

Gerald Johnson, better known as Papa, passed from this earthly life surrounded by his family on October 24, 2023. Gerald was born December 24, 1939, in Kenedy, Texas to Fred & Helen Johnson. He was raised on the Johnson Farm with his four brothers, where they grew up helping their father with all aspects of farming and raising livestock. He attended Kenedy High School and later Texas A&I Kingsville, where he graduated with a degree in Bachelor of Science.

He met his wife, Marlene Schmidt, at a dance, and they married in September of 1961. In their first years of marriage they lived in Corpus Christi, Texas. The couple moved to Victoria, Texas in January of 1963, and welcomed their son, Mark, shortly after. During this time, Gerald worked at the Devereux School and taught there until 1967, which was also the year they welcomed their second son, Brad. The family were active members of the First English Lutheran Church while in Victoria.

In 1970, the family made the move to El Campo, Texas, where Gerald started selling insurance for Texas Farmer's Union. He spent many years as a representative for his peers at Texas Farmer's Union events and was a lifelong member. During this time, he returned to his passion of teaching, which he did for thirty-three years for El Campo ISD. He later retired in 2001. Even in retirement, he enjoyed spending his time substitute teaching for the

district. During his years in ECISD, Gerald was known for announcing middle school football for many years and Friday night games for the high school for a few years. Nothing excited him more than cheering on the El Campo Ricebirds. Gerald was an active member of the First Lutheran Church, where he taught Sunday school and served as a member on the church council. Gerald was also dedicated to being a part of his children's activities, never missing a ball game or a tennis match. This also carried forward to his grandchildren, as Papa would always be seen spending most Saturdays at swim meets or dance competitions. Words cannot express how much they will miss his support.

Gerald was a current member of Christ Lutheran Church and enjoyed being a past member of the choir and of the church council. He enjoyed praising the Lord with his voice every single Sunday. Gerald was an avid swimmer and spent most days at the EC Aquatic Center getting in his exercise. Gerald delighted in playing dominoes at the Heritage Center, and loved Friday night football where he was still attending those home games. It was always fun being with Papa as many times, random people would stop us and say, "Mr. Johnson, you were my favorite teacher!" It always amazed us how many people's lives Gerald made an impact on.

Gerald was preceded in death by his parents Fred & Helen Johnson, In-Laws Johnny & Marguerite Schmidt, Brothers James Johnson & Clarence Johnson, Sister-in-laws Barbara Johnson, Wanda Johnson, Cindy Johnson, Iverrene Johnson & Sherry Barnhart, Brother-in-laws Jay Schmidt, John Wayne Schmidt, Chuck Edgar & Carl Barnhart, nieces, and nephews.
