



Gladys Vera Trojcek Mood

January 25, 1923 - January 28, 2015

Gladys Vera Trojcek Mood, 92, of San Antonio passed away on January 28, 2015. She was born on January 25, 1923, in Sublime, Texas to the late Emilie Frances Woytek and Frank Joe Trojcek.

Gladys attended Midfield Public School and Blessing High School.

She also attended Southwestern Business University in Houston 1942. After a year of business school, she began working for the government at Camp Hulen (Palacios, TX) as a secretary, and transferred to Foster Field (Victoria) and worked until the end of WWII. Gladys enjoyed dancing and attended many dances in the area at the USO and Camp Hulen Field House.

Gladys enjoyed traveling and seeing the world. In 1953 to 1954, with husband Rene (in the Army) she lived in Yokohama, Japan, Huntsville, Alabama (1954-1955), then to Karlsruhe and Kitzingen, Germany, until 1958. While living in Germany she traveled to Garmish, Heidelberg, Nurnberg, Bertchesgarden, Baden-Baden, Kaiserslauten, Rutengerg, Belgium, Holland, Leichenstein, Switzerland, Austria, and France.

She and Rene were stationed at Fort Bliss (El Paso) and to Huntsville, Alabama. In 1974, Gladys moved back to San Antonio, Texas. Gladys served her country by working with the Government for over 20 years – she retired in 1977.

Gladys and Rene opened up an office supply and a dry cleaners business.

Gladys volunteered in several Republican Senatorial campaigns and was employed by the Bexar County Republican Headquarters to work the General Elections and Runoffs in 1988 – 1996. She had the task of locating over 599 voting locations in Bexar County and San Antonio, plus assigning the Presiding Judges and Alternate Judges, and approximately 1,190 clerks to work the elections.

In 1992, she became a member of OASIS (Older Adult Service and Information System) and volunteered with them for over 17 years.

Gladys is survived by her daughters Dr. Carolyn Hatton of Dallas, her son Jeffrey and wife Jennifer of Lubbock and their children Jace, Reagan, and Ryder; Rosalyn Wise of San Antonio; and Marilyn McDowell and husband Bob of Houston and son Austin McDowell and wife Brittany of Houston, son Haden McDowell, and daughter Katie McDowell of Austin; brother Frank William Trojcak and wife Sophie of San Antonio, their children Karen Eckert and husband Danny, children Jennifer and Nathan; Lyndel Trojcak; Frank and wife Vickie and son, Adam.

She was preceded in death by her parents and sister Miladie Lillie Trojcak Kana Carroll.

Visitation will begin on Friday, February 6, 2015, at 12 pm at Triska Funeral Home. Funeral Services will follow at 1pm at the funeral home with Pastor Donna Zipp officiating. Burial will follow at Garden of Memories Cemetery.
