Gloria Schoelman Schoenfield, 75, a life-long resident of El Campo, died April 10, 2015 after a two year battle with pancreatic cancer. She was born on September 22, 1939 in El Campo to the late Frank and Evelyn Rieger Schoelman. She loved being a cattle rancher and also farmed rice and watermelons. She was an avid hunter and above all, she loved and treasured her family.

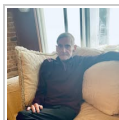
