Harold Edward Mickelson Jr. passed away on March 19, 2012 at his home surrounded by his family and friends.

Harold was born on June 11, 1943 to Harold Emmanuel and Evelyn Leisker Mickelson in Houston. Harold graduated from El Campo High School in 1961 and attended the University of Houston for two years before he came back to El Campo to help his father run the company business Mickelson Pump Shop Inc. Harold was the third generation of a 110 year old business.

Harold married the love of his life, Karen Halamicek on Jan 25, 1964.

Harold is survived by his wife, Karen Mickelson of El Campo, sons Todd Edward Mickelson of El Campo, Scott Wesley Mickelson and wife Kimberly of El Campo, daughter Kari Kaye Mickelson of Pierce and fiancée B.
