



Henrietta Agnes Bram

September 7, 1922 - April 3, 2017

Henrietta Agnes Peters Bram passed away on Monday, April 3, 2017, surrounded by her loving family. Henrietta was born on September 7, 1922, in Schulenburg, Texas, to Charles and Jane Shimek Peters. Henrietta was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother and friend, and she was known as “Memo” to her four grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren. She enjoyed spending time with her family. Her grandchildren were here her greatest joy, and in her later years, Henrietta said that her great-grandchildren were the “light of her life.”

Henrietta was married to Otto Christian Bram for almost 62 years. Henrietta met Otto in Danevang, Texas, and they were married in Midfield, Texas, on February 18, 1947. The couple made their home in Danevang for the entirety of their marriage, and they farmed in and around the Danevang area until Otto’s retirement. Henrietta was a proud homemaker, and she helped Otto on the farm doing everything from driving tractors to shoveling levies while raising their two sons, Vernon and Leroy. Otto was the center of her world. Henrietta missed him greatly and was ready to be with him again after his passing in 2008.

Henrietta loved teaching her grandchildren and great-grandchildren to cook and bake. Baking was a specialty of hers as she always had an array of sweet treats for anyone who came to visit. Her grandchildren loved to come visit

Memo to help her bake her famous cinnamon rolls and Danish spritz cookies. Henrietta often made specialty wedding and birthday cakes for family and friends.

Henrietta was involved in the Veterans of Foreign War Ladies Auxiliary in which she served as past president. For over 60 years, Henrietta was an active member of the Danevang Community. She held many offices in the Danevang Lutheran Church as well as in the Danevang Ladies Aide. Henrietta and Otto, a World War II Veteran, were very patriotic and supportive of military veterans. They were instrumental in implementing the program at the Danevang Lutheran Church Cemetery where flags are placed on graves in memory of veterans who proudly served.

Henrietta is survived by her sons, Vernon Bram and wife Connie of Bay City and Leroy Bram and wife Billie Jean of Danevang grandchildren: Jason Bram and wife Jessica of Austin; Amy Sherrill and husband Jason of Wimberley; LeAnne Lundy and husband Derik of Sugar Land; and Cori Bram and fiancé Kevin Koudela of Louise; great grandchildren: Jake, Brady and Cooper Bram; Dylan Carr and Harper Sherrill; Jacqueline, Ellis and Asa Lundy.
