January 21, 1929 - April 19, 2016

Inez Vasquez Gonzalez, 87, an El Campo resident since 1944, passed away April 19, 2016. She was born on January 21, 1929 in Weesatche, TX to retired cotton farmers, the late Marcos and Reyes Rangel Vasquez.

Inez, along with her husband Raul, owned 5th St. Grocery Store in the late 50's and 60's. She owned the first Hispanic beauty salon in El Campo for 30 years, Inez Vasquez Beauty Salon. She also went to work for H-E-B in El Campo as a cashier and retired in 1994. She was one of the founding members of the Guadalupanas, Legion of Mary, Catholic Daughters and a lifetime member of St. Robert's Catholic Church. Inez was a leader in the El Campo Band Parents Club. She also loved to cook, garden and play Sudoku.

She is survived by her children, Ruben Gonzalez of Rosharon, Annabelle Gonzalez of El Campo; Esther Gonzalez Villela and husband Joe of Rosenberg; Abel Gonzalez of Lake Jackson, Carlos Gonzalez and wife Sylvia of Eagle Lake and Adela Gonzalez of Rosenberg; grandchildren, Jennifer Salazar and husband Christopher of Clear Lake, Annabelle Villela of Rosenberg, Kristen Gonzalez of Lake Jackson, Carlos J.
