



Isabel "Mama H" Hernandez

August 1, 1946 - May 31, 2012

Isabel Munoz Hernandez, "Mama H", of El Campo died May 31, 2012 at the age of 65. She was born August 1, 1946 in Wharton, Texas. In 1973, she and her husband opened up Hernandez Nursery, which they operated for 35 years. During that time, Mama H became known for her wonderful home cooking, and in 1983, they opened Casa Hernandez Mexican Restaurant, which they operated for 25 years before their retirement.

She is survived by her husband of 49 years, Joe D.
