J.J. Hill, Jr., 93, of El Campo, passed away October 30, 2019 in El Campo. He was born on September 20, 1926 in El Campo to the late Jasper James and Louise Head Hill. J.J. married Ada Alleene Ladewig on December 1, 1951. He was a rice farmer and laser levee surveyor before retiring at the age of 85. He is known for being a Little League coach, an avid golfer, a square dancer and a domino player. J.J. was a member of St. Philip the Apostle Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus Council 2490 and served on the boards of Rice Farmers Coop, Rice Marketing Association and the Texas Rice Council.
