We shouted at each other but couldn’t do a thing. From there, we became friends. I would go over to his house or to a fenced in area where we would ride goats or calves. It was great fun. Once a goat caught him in the face and he had three stitches to mend the wound.

I remember when he first started hunting. A deer attacked his blind and scared him to death.

We went through Elementary, Junior High, and High School together as friends. We played softball, track, baseball, and football together over the years. Jim was a tough guy in football, a fullback who gave his all. He wouldn’t back down.

I remember when Jim got interested in Debbie. He took me to her house several times...tried to get me to go snipe hunting. Those were the days.

In later years, I would stop by and visit when I was in town. I so enjoyed visiting with them, setting around the kitchen table. Occasionally we would go out to eat or go to his house for some cold beverages and talk about friends or the state of the nation. Jim and Debbie’s house was always open to everybody. They always showed me great hospitality.

I will miss Jimbo, as I called him many times. I know that it is a sad time for all, to have someone as precious and close to you has been severed from this world. I want to tell you, “I am so sorry.” I wanted to be there, but a relapse of Hepatitis has made it impossible. I want

you to know that I loved Jim and will miss him a great deal. May God give rest and peace to his soul.
