James Marion Moore, 67 of El Campo, passed away on August 12, 2014. He was born on October 23, 1946 in Texarkana to the late Robert Cyril and Avis Caddenhead Moore.

He graduated from Mt. Pleasant High School, and East Texas State University. He earned his Masters degree from Prairie View A & M University. He coached for 30 years and taught math for 39 years. His stops included; Sheriden, Rice Consolidated, Rockport, Hempstead, El Campo and Lamar Consolidated. "Coach Moore" was the head basketball coach at Hempstead HS for 8 years and El Campo HS for 14 years before retiring from coaching with over 300 wins. He was an auctioneer and owned Moore's Hillje Auction. He was a member of the First Baptist Church.

Coach Moore was passionate about all of his endeavors; whether it was coaching, teaching, pursuing deals at garage sales or his auction. He pursued life to the fullest, giving glory to God.

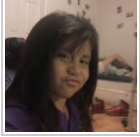
