Jason Schuch Klinksiek, born on August 16, 1967, passed away peacefully at his El Campo Texas home on August 30, 2025.

Jason was preceded in death by his mother, Merlyn Irene Klinksiek and infant brother Harold Louis Klinksiek, Jr. He is survived by his father Harold Louis Klinksiek of College Station Texas and sister Leslie Gayle Klinksiek of Houston Texas.

Jason's life was a special one. He was placed on this earth as an envoy of Christ. Jason had special needs, and as such, his life touched so many people. This started with the first special education program in Fredericksburg Texas. At age 11 he moved out of the house to be part of a new program the Texas Elks Foundation was starting. After 5 months he moved to a residential school in San Antonio where he lived for 5 years, until they could no longer help him. The Texas Education Agency put Jason in contact with someone who had previously run a school for difficult children. A new facility was started in Houston Texas with Jason as the first client. As more clients were added they moved to Sugarland Texas and then Manvel Texas. Jason lived here until no longer eligible at 22 years of age. God was with Jason all this time, and He now brought new angels into Jason's life. Jake and Donna Payne started a new residential facility and school in El Campo Texas in 1994 and this is where Jason lived for the rest of his life. The organization, now called

Memeeha, became home to many other children in need. More houses were built, and many loving caretakers filled the homes and school with love.

As Jason's family we are so thankful to God for allowing us to share in Jason's life while he shared his life with so many others. Now God was ready for Jason to join Him in his forever home.
