



## Jerome Joseph Dusek

March 1, 1924 - December 15, 2016

Jerome Joseph Dusek, 92, of El Campo, passed away December 15, 2016. He was born on March 1, 1924 in Ammansville, TX to the late John J. Dusek and Angelina Janak Dusek. Jerome was a U.S. Navy Veteran of WWII. He was awarded eight Battle Stars and a Bronze Star Medal for his service. He was employed by Transcontinental Gas Pipeline as a compressor station operator until retirement in 1983.
