Jerome Edward Trochta, formerly of Ganado and El Campo, died May 9, 2011 at the age of 88. He was born on November 26, 1922 in League City to the late John and Frances Mozisek Trochta. He was a loan officer for PCA in El Campo for over 35 years before his retirement in 1983. He served in the US Army during WWII, and was a member of the American Legion Post 251 and the Knights of Columbus 2490.
