Jerry Frank Mondrik, 79 of Louise passed away on December 28, 2011. He was born on May 18, 1932 in El Maton to the late Ladislav and Filomena Janak Mondrik. He served in the US Army during the Korean War from 1953-1956. He attained the rank of Staff Sergeant and his primary duty assignment was with A Battery 2nd Anti-Aircraft Artillery Battalion of the First Armored Division. He was especially proud of the Good Conduct Medal, Sharpshooters Badge, and the Korean Service Medals that he received. He was a lifetime member of the VFW.
