



## Johnnie Bartosh

July 15, 1928 - March 10, 2023

Johnnie Henry Bartosh, 94, of El Campo, passed away March 10, 2023. He was born on July 15, 1928 in Ammannsville, TX to the late Willie Joe and Matilda Cernosek Bartosh. Johnnie graduated from El Campo High School in 1946. He was the Czech language translator while serving in the Army in Germany. He then graduated from Wharton County Junior College and attended the University of Texas in Austin. He worked at Modern Farmer's Co-Op in El Campo, tax preparer and accountant for Ernest Opella and was a rural mail carrier for the El Campo Post Office. Johnnie enjoyed bowling, deer hunting, playing Tarok and loved watching Longhorn sports. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council #2490 and lifelong member of the VFW.

He is survived by his wife of 55 years, Margaret Trobl Bartosh; son, Shawn Bartosh and wife Dawn; grandchildren, Ryan Bartosh and fiancé Delaine Valensuela, Reed Bartosh and Skylar Bartosh; sisters, Willie Mae Janksy and Genevieve Dornak and husband J.V.; sister-in-law, Kathy Bartosh and numerous nieces and nephews.

Johnnie was preceded in death by his parents; sister, Janie Ann Stavinoha; brothers, Allen and Billy Bartosh; infant brother, Andrew Bartosh and brother-in-law, Joe Jansky.

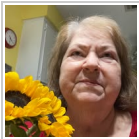
