



Joycelyn Smith Henderson

December 14, 1921 - December 7, 2023

Joycelyn Smith Henderson passed away peacefully in Horseshoe Bay, Texas on December 7, 2023. She was born in Brisbane, Australia on December 14, 1921 to James Smith and Clara McGee Smith, the fourth of five children. In 1942, she met her husband, Staff Sergeant Paul Henderson who was stationed with General Douglas MacArthur's headquarters in Brisbane. Subsequently, they were married on July 4, 1944 and celebrated over 50 years of marriage together. Joyce was welcomed to El Campo by Paul's family in early 1945 and immediately fell in love with them and his family with her. Paul returned to El Campo in June of 1945 from his military service and they established their home in El Campo.

Paul and Joyce were blessed with four children -- Patricia, Mark, Bruce and Paula.

Joyce was a devoted wife, mother to four, grandmother to 10 and great grandmother to 14 children, as well as a mentor to numerous people in the El Campo community.

Joyce had a servant heart, and the City of El Campo witnessed her love and passion for the community she called home. Faith, family, friends and community were her highest priorities.

Dedicated to her faith, Joyce held numerous positions in the First Methodist Church serving as Sunday school teacher, Director of Christian Education, Board Chair & Lay Leader. In the early 1970s, she worked with others to create the Methodist Child Care Center providing loving child care for working mothers. In the early days of the Child Care Center when money was tight, Joyce was often making soup and sandwiches to provide healthy meals for the children.

When her daughters became involved in Girl Scouts, Joyce became a troop leader and chairman of the cookie sales. Other civic involvement included working with others to open the first Head Start program in El Campo, working on the Parks and Recreation board as Chair to open Friendship Park, serving on El Campo Hospital Board from 1975-2008, El Campo Medical Foundation Board from 1974 -2010 as grant writer and fundraiser.

Joyce was known for her excellent cooking. She enjoyed singing in the choir, shopping with her daughters and traveling. She returned to her homeland 8 times in her long life.

Joyce was recognized in 1973 as the El Campo Citizen of the Year and in 2004 she was given the Americanism Award by the DAR for her contributions to aid others in obtaining their United States citizenship.

Joyce recognized the needs of others and was always compassionate and quick to lend an ear and come to the aid of family, friends and neighbors.

Preceding her in death are her loving husband, Paul, her brother, Ron Smith, sisters, Mavis Linton-Smith, and Alice Morris, father-in law, Jess Henderson, mother-in-law, Maude Henderson, sister-in law, Helen Naiser, & brother-in-law, John Calvin Henderson.

Surviving her are her sister Thelma of Brisbane Australia, her four children, Patricia Kittredge & husband Robert of Fort Worth, son Mark Henderson and wife Kathleen of Prescott, Arizona, Bruce Henderson and wife Maureen of Scottsdale, Arizona, & Paula Wendel & husband Tommy of Horseshoe Bay , 10 grandchildren, Juliet Morgan, Jennifer Kamacioglu (Murat), Jess Henderson, Clay Ellwood, Ross Henderson (Nichole), Lauren Burnett (Steve), Matthew Henderson (Griselda), Justin Wendel (Jennifer), Jake Henderson (Lindsay), Tara Buntin (Scott), 14 great grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews in the United States and Australia.

Family will receive friends from 4-6 p.m. Monday, December 11, 2023 at Triska Funeral Home. Funeral services will begin at 11 a.m. Tuesday, December 12, 2023 at First United Methodist Church in El Campo with Rev. Ellen Ely officiating.
