



## Lanus Leon Treadwell

September 28, 1948 - January 12, 2017

Lanus Leon Treadwell, 68, of El Campo, passed away on January 12, 2017. He was born on September 28, 1948 in El Campo to the late Lanus Albert and Clara Brodsgaard Treadwell. He was employed by Conoco for 34 years in oilfield production and then retired as an oilfield consultant. With his work he traveled to several places including Australia, Vietnam, Indonesia, Singapore, Gulf of Mexico, all over Texas and many states in America. Lanus was a 1967 graduate of El Campo High School and earned a scholarship to Baylor University where he played football. He was an avid sports fan and hunter.

He is survived by his wife, Sheryl Osina Treadwell of El Campo; sons, Derek Treadwell and Kevin Treadwell, both of Denton and brothers, Glenn Treadwell of Austin and Bruce Treadwell of El Campo.

Lanus was preceded in death by his parents and sister, Kathryn Treadwell.
