



## Lois York Cannell

Lois York Cannell of El Campo died January 2, 2025 at the age of 92. She was born in Spur, Texas on January 2, 1933 to John E. and Birdie Hairgrove York. She was the bookkeeper and office manager for the family business, Cannell Air Conditioning, for the past 50 years. She served the El Campo community as a Cub Master for Cub Scouts, and was a member of Pilot Club for 42 years and served as president in 1986-87 and again in 1998-99. She was also a long-time Rotary Ann at the Rotary Club of El Campo annual fundraiser and brought in the excel spreadsheet for their auction items.
