It is with deep sorrow that we announce that Lorene Kram, 97, of El Campo, passed away on Wednesday, June 15, 2022. She was born on June 22, 1924 in Shiner, Texas to the late Steve and Christina Kurtz Michalec.

Lorene married Arnold Kram in Shiner, Texas at St. Cyril and Methodius Catholic Church on November 6, 1944 and moved to El Campo, Texas in 1945. She worked hard staying home and raising their five children. She loved to sew the clothes for her daughters and herself and was an avid gardener growing and canning the produce grown from their garden.
