



## Louis Roderick "Rod" Ilse

February 11, 1927 - May 30, 2025

Louis Roderick "Rod" Ilse, 98, passed away peacefully on May 30, 2025. Born in Glendale, California, on February 11, 1927, to James Henry Ilse and Mildred Berry Ilse. Rod lived a long, full life devoted to family, community, and service.

Rod attended Redondo High School and later studied at the University of California at Santa Barbara. After moving to Texas, he earned a bachelor's degree in agriculture from the University of Houston. On January 1, 1955, he began his lifelong work on the Ilse Ranch.

A proud veteran, Rod served in the United States Coast Guard during World War II. He was an active member of the Elks Lodge, where he served as Exalted Ruler, and was a member of the American Legion.

In 1965, Rod married the love of his life, Elsie Trcka Tomanek. With that union came a blended family of six children, and together they welcomed their youngest daughter, Nancy. Rod embraced each child as his own, and he was deeply devoted to all his family, who lovingly called him daddy, grandpa, and papa.
