



## Louis M. "Bootsie" Dzierzanowski

February 21, 1933 - January 31, 2015

Louis M. "Bootsie" Dzierzanowski, age 81, of El Campo, passed away on January 31, 2015. He was born on February 21, 1933 in Rosenberg to the late John and Louise Novak Dzierzanowski.
