Dr. Lowell Stephen Miller, 96, of Nada, passed away April 7, 2017. He was born on March 16, 1921 in Springfield, Ohio to the late Floyd V. Miller and Ethel Ellen Carpenter Miller. He was a U.S. Navy Veteran and a retired Fellow of the American College of Radiology and a Fellow of the Society of Therapeutic Radiation Oncology. 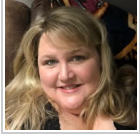
