



## Luke Callahan Dromgoole

Luke Callahan Dromgoole passed away peacefully in his parents' arms at Memorial Hermann Hospital in Katy, TX on Friday, June 30, 2017. He was born on Sunday, June 25, 2017 at Memorial Hermann Hospital in Katy. Born 13 weeks early and weighing only 2 lbs, 9 oz, Luke was a strong fighter. He was baptized by Memorial Hermann Chaplain Jerry Thomas on June 27. During his short time on this earth he touched the lives of the hospital staff, brought thousands in surrounding communities to God in prayer, and through bloodwork, gave doctors vital information that is credited with saving the life of his mother.

Luke is survived by his parents, Glenn & Delana Dromgoole of Garwood and brothers, Jackson Dromgoole, age 22 months and Clayton Joines, age 9. He is also survived by his grandparents, Fulton Jr. and Frances Dromgoole of Elm Grove, Mitchel & Patsy Smith of Garwood; uncles & aunt, Brennan & Dr. Lori Jobe of Columbus and Fulton Dromgoole, III of Austin; and great-grand-papaw, David Hengst of Eagle Lake.

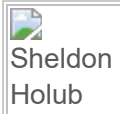
