Luther Dean Bandy, 89, went to be with our Lord July 3, 2015. He was born November 12, 1925 in Humble to the late Drew "Slim" and Lela Marie Cheatham Bandy. He was the last surviving member of the El Campo Bandy family.

He was a lifelong resident of El Campo. He was an El Campo High School graduate then worked his first job at the movie theater collecting tickets, then was employed at Coca Cola for five years and then worked with his dad driving a dump truck to haul gravel and grain for 15 years.
