



## Margaret J. Naiser

February 17, 1917 - June 22, 2016

On June 22, 2016, God opened his arms and welcomed Margaret Naiser into her eternal rest. She died peacefully at home after a full life of 99 years.

Margaret was born in Bernardo, TX, on February 17, 1917, to the late Frances (Henneke) and John Rolf. The family later moved to Jones Creek, and then to El Campo.

Margaret graduated from El Campo High School in 1935. She attended Victoria Jr. College and then Southwest Texas State Teachers' College during the summers when she began teaching. From 1937 to 1940, she was one of two teachers at the Isaacson School, where she taught first through third grades along with Evelyn Kainer, who taught the fourth through sixth graders. On June 2, 1941, she married Raymond Naiser, to whom she was married for almost 69 years. Margaret was a devout Catholic, a devoted family member, and a good friend to many. She was a member of the Catholic Daughters, Court 1374, for many years.

Margaret devoted most of her adult life to being a wife, mother, grandmother and full-time homemaker. She was an accomplished seamstress, an excellent cook, and a gardener. Her kitchen was usually filled with the scents of fresh kolaches or chocolate cake and at certain times of year you could find her canning pickles or making huge pans of cornbread dressing. When not in the

kitchen, she was usually at her sewing machine making little girls' dresses, or out in the garden, or helping a child with homework. In later years, she enjoyed her six grandchildren and a good game of dominos. She also helped in the care of her husband during his illness. Margaret's gentleness and kindness will be greatly missed by those who loved her.

She is preceded in death by her parents, her husband Raymond, her daughter Carolyn Hill, brothers Alvin Rolf, Andrew Rolf, Allen Rolf and John Rolf, and sisters Regina Kainer, Emily Rolf, Marie Wilderman, and Doris Johnson.

She is survived by her two daughters, Janie and husband Billy Rioux of El Campo and Annette and husband Bill Isaacson of Bay City; son David Naiser of Austin; and son-in-law David Hill of Spring.
