



## Myrtle Mary Fucik

December 5, 1913 - May 29, 2015

Myrtle Mary Brod Fucik, 101, of El Campo passed away on May 29, 2015. She was born on December 5, 1913 in Mentz, Texas to the late John Jacob and Theresa Ritter Brod. She was a homemaker who enjoyed playing dominoes, sewing, flower and vegetable gardening, and baking, especially molasses cookies.
