



Norelle Hicks Lundy

June 27, 1947 - January 5, 2024

Norelle Hicks Lundy died peacefully at home on January 5, 2024, at the age of 76. She was born June 24, 1947, in Austin, Texas, to Norelle and Miller Hicks. While attending Baylor University she met her husband of almost 54 years, DB Lundy. They married on Valentine's Day, 1970, and began a family in El Campo, Texas. Norelle was an accomplished and well-respected physical therapist who followed a passion, which began in childhood, to care for others. She provided pain and rehabilitation services for over 50 years including, over the last 20 years of her career, operating Detar Hospital's in-house and out-patient clinical facilities in Victoria, Texas. A key accomplishment for her at Detar, was building an aquatic therapy program which was rare during that time. Norelle's work brought her immense joy, and her skills provided relief and support for thousands of patients. She was a member of the First Baptist Church in El Campo and her faith was a great blessing and source of comfort. She was actively involved in the El Campo Boys & Girls Club and was a board member for many years. She was also a member of the Sesame Club and enjoyed gifting and reading books to elementary students.

Norelle had a heart of gold and a smile that could light up any room. She will be remembered as a loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister, loyal friend and one that generously devoted her time to helping others. She was known for her kindness, compassion, and selflessness. She was adored and treasured by all the hearts that she touched. She was always up for an adventure —

especially if it involved spending time on the water — and she displayed infinite hope and optimism all her life — even while battling the cruelties of Alzheimer's over the last seven years. The memory of Norelle's unique laugh and arms for a hug will live in our hearts forever.

Norelle is preceded in death by her parents and brother, Malcolm Hicks. She is survived by her husband DB Lundy; daughter, Norelle Becker and husband Brian; son, Derik Lundy and wife LeAnne; brother, Greg Hicks; grandchildren — for whom she will always be remembered as "MiMi," Jacqueline Lundy; Ellis Lundy; Asa Lundy; Jarod Becker and Jeremy Becker.

A Memorial Service will be held 2:00 pm on Friday, January 12, 2024, at First Baptist Church of El Campo with Reverend Rick DuBroc and Reverend Omar Garcia officiating.
